

**Organic Law of Georgia**  
**Amendments and Supplements to the Organic Law of Georgia**  
**“Election Code of Georgia”**

**Article 1.** Following amendments and supplements shall be made to the Organic Law of Georgia on the “Election Code of Georgia” (Legal Newsletter, N25, 22.08.2001. Article 107):

1. **Article 27, shall be formulated as follows:** “**Article 27.** Establishment of Central Election Committee of Georgia CEC two members are appointed by those political parties, who are funded by the state budget according to the Organic Law of Georgia on “Citizens Political Alliances”; article 30 and 39; item 4“;
2. **Article 32, item 1 shall be formulated as follows:** “Regional Election Committee two members are appointed by those political parties, who are funded by the state budget according to the Organic Law of Georgia on “Citizens Political Alliances”; article 30 and 39; item 4. “;
3. **Article 36 shall be formulated as follows:**  
“**Article 36.** Establishment of District Election Committee  
1. Presinct election committee two members are appointed by those political parties, who are funded by the state budget according to the Organic Law of Georgia on “Citizens Political Alliances”; article 30 and 39; item 4. “  
2. 6 Members of District Election Committees established in the different states are elected by the majority of CEC members”.
4. **Article 108; item 2 shall be formulated as follows:** "2. Election day of the Local self-Government Representative Body – Sakrebulo is set by the president of Georgia, none later than 45 days before the expiration day of the Sakrebulo authority and none later than 60 days before the election".
5. **Article 126 1 shall be formulated as follows:** “Tbilisi Sakrebulo Elections are conducted proportionally”;
6. **Articles:** 126<sup>5</sup>, 126<sup>6</sup>, 126<sup>9</sup>, 126<sup>11</sup>, 126<sup>12</sup> and 126<sup>13</sup> as well as, the article 126<sup>13</sup>; item 1 and article 126<sup>15</sup>; item 1 shall be extracted.
7. **Article 129; item 1 shall be extracted;**

Article 2. The Law shall be effective immediately upon its publication
